

THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (CONTROL OF EXPORT AND DELIVERY FOR EXPORT) (No. 3) REGULATIONS, 1963

Made ... .. 3rd May, 1963  
 Coming into operation .. .. 5th May, 1963

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section three of the Export of Produce (Control of Export and Delivery for Export) Ordinance, 1956, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. For the purposes of these Regulations, the expression "produce" means produce, other than tomatoes.
2. On and after the date of the coming into force of these Regulations, produce for Export as East Train Traffic on any of the days set out in the left hand column of the Schedule to these Regulations, shall not be delivered to the Harbour of Saint Peter Port on any day in any week other than on the days set out in the centre column of the said Schedule respectively and shall not on any of those days set out in the centre column of the said Schedule be delivered for export to the said Harbour later than the times set out in the right hand column of the said Schedule respectively: provided that produce delivered for export to the said Harbour and consigned to London for shipment by Mail Steamer on any Friday, shall be so delivered not later than seven-thirty o'clock in the forenoon.
3. The Export of Produce (Control of Export and Delivery for Export) (No. 2) Regulations, 1963, are hereby repealed.
4. These Regulations shall come into force on the fifth day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
