THE ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS (IMPORTATION) (CARCASSES) ORDER, 1963.

The States Committee for Agriculture, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section eleven of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section nine of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, the importation into this Island from the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland of carcasses which are unfit for human consumption and which are intended for feeding to dogs and cats is hereby prohibited unless:-

- (a) in respect of each consignment of such carcasses there shall have been issued by the States Committee for Agriculture a licence in that behalf, and
- (b) each carcass has been fully cooked throughout the whole of its substance, and
- (c) each carcass has been dyed blue with an indelible dye.

2. Any cloth, wrapping or sacking or other material which has been used for, or in connection with, the wrapping of any such carcass imported as aforesaid shall be destroyed at the expense of the importer thereof in such manner and at such place as the States Veterinary Officer may direct.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Order may be cited as the Animals and Animal Products (Importation) (Carcasses) Order, 1963

5. This Order shall come into force on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
