

The Import Duties (European Free Trade Association)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1963

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by section two of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. In section one of the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Guernsey) Order, 1960, as amended, (a) the words "to the Bailiwick" are hereby repealed.
2. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association (Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1963, and this Order and the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Guernsey) Orders, 1960 to 1962, may be cited together as the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Guernsey) Orders, 1960 to 1963.
2. (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
2. (3) This Order shall come into force on the second day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
