

The Parking Places Order, 1963.

MADE 12th August, 1963.
COMING INTO OPERATION 12th August, 1963.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby order:-

1. The areas and parts, set out in the third column of the Schedule to this order, of the public highways set out in the second column of that Schedule respectively opposite thereto are hereby designated approved parking places and are hereafter in this order referred to by the numbers respectively assigned to them in the first column of that Schedule.
2. A person, being in charge of a motor delivery vehicle, shall not park that motor delivery vehicle in approved parking places Nos. 1, 2, 3, 11, 14, 18, 23, 26, 27 or 30.
3. A person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle, shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, park that vehicle or motor bicycle -
 - (a) subject to the succeeding provisions of this section, in any approved parking place, other than approved parking places Nos. 6, 8, 9, 10 and 28 for any continuous period greater than a period of four hours;
 - (b) in approved parking places Nos. 11 or 14 between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and six o'clock in the afternoon on any week day, other than a bank holiday, for any continuous period greater than a period of one hour between the said hours;
 - (c) in approved parking place No. 13 for any continuous period greater than a period of fifteen minutes in any continuous period of sixty minutes during the hours in which the Public Markets are open for business;
 - (d) in approved parking places Nos. 15 or 16 during the hours in which the Public Markets are open for business save that a person being in charge of a motor delivery vehicle may park that motor delivery vehicle in either of those approved parking places for any continuous period not greater than a period of one hundred and twenty minutes during the said hours;
 - (e) in approved parking places Nos. 8 or 9 at any time when those parking places are being used, or are required for use, in connection with any vessel.
4. A person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle, who parks that vehicle or motor bicycle, as the case may be -
 - (a) in approved parking place No. 2 shall so park it that its longitudinal axis is at an angle of forty-five degrees to the wall on the east side of Hirzel Street, is facing north east and is abreast of, and in single line with, any other vehicle or motor bicycle parked therein;

- (b) in approved parking place No. 9 shall so park it that -
 - (i) if parked around the edges of Victoria Pier its longitudinal axis is at right angles to the edge of the said Pier; and
 - (ii) if parked in the centre of the carriageway of the said Pier it is facing west;
- (c) in approved parking place No. 8 shall so park it that it faces west;
- (d) in approved parking place No. 11 shall so park it that its longitudinal axis is at an angle of forty-five degrees to the wall of the Bonded Stores, is facing west and is abreast of, and in single line with, any other vehicle or motor bicycle parked therein;
- (e) in approved parking place No. 14 shall so park it that its longitudinal axis is at an angle of forty-five degrees to the edge of the kerb, is facing west and is abreast of, and in single line with, any other vehicle or motor bicycle parked therein;
- (f) in approved parking place No. 15 shall so park it that its longitudinal axis is at right angles to the kerb, is facing north and is abreast of, and in single line with, any other vehicle or motor bicycle parked therein;
- (g) in approved parking place No. 21 shall not park it opposite the entrance to the Fire Station or otherwise in such manner as to obstruct or hinder the ready entrance to, or exit from, the Fire Station of any fire engine or other fire fighting appliance;
- (h) in approved parking place No. 23 shall so park it that it is facing downhill;
- (i) in approved parking place No. 27 shall so park it that it is facing east and is abreast of, and in line with, any other vehicle or motor bicycle parked therein;
- (j) in approved parking place No. 29 shall so park it that it faces the sea wall and is abreast of, and in single line with, any other vehicle or motor bicycle parked therein;
- (k) in any approved parking place, other than one of those specified in paragraphs (a) to (k) of this section, both paragraphs inclusive, shall park it in single line with and behind or in front of, as the case may be, any other vehicle or motor bicycle parked in the same approved parking place.

5. A person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle, who parks that vehicle or motor bicycle in an approved parking place in which vehicles are required in pursuance of the provisions of the last preceding section to be parked abreast of, and in single line with, other vehicles or motor bicycle parked therein, shall park that vehicle or motor bicycle as close as is reasonably practicable to any other vehicle or motor bicycle parked therein or, if no other vehicle or motor bicycle is parked therein, to that extremity of the approved parking place which is on the off-side of the vehicle or motor bicycle.

6. A person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle, who parks that vehicle or motor bicycle in an approved parking place in which vehicles are required in pursuance of the provisions of the last preceding section to be parked in a single line and one behind the other, shall park that vehicle or motor bicycle with its near side as close as is reasonably practicable to the extremity of the approved parking place which is farthest from traffic moving in the vicinity of that parking place and as close as is reasonably practicable to any vehicle or motor bicycle parked ahead or to the rear of it or, if no vehicle or motor bicycle is parked ahead or to the rear of it, to one or other of the extremities of the approved parking place lying parallel to the axis of the vehicle or the motor bicycle, as the case may be.
7. A person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle which is parked in an approved parking place shall move that vehicle or motor bicycle, as the case may be, from that approved parking place or from any part of that approved parking place to any other part thereof on the request of any person having reasonable grounds for making such request or at the request of a police officer.
8. In this order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:-

"bank holiday" means a day appointed as a bank holiday by Ordinance;

"the Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the salaried police force;

"police officer" means a member of the salaried police force and, within the limit of his jurisdiction, a member of the special constabulary;

"motor delivery vehicle" means any vehicle which is designed or constructed for use wholly or mainly for the carriage of goods.
9. Notwithstanding the preceding provisions of this order, the Chief Officer may in his discretion, from time to time, close any approved parking place by exhibiting or causing to be exhibited thereon in such manner as to be clearly visible to a person intending to park a vehicle or a motor bicycle thereon a notice stating that the approved parking place is closed and is not available for the parking of vehicles or motor bicycles and may in his discretion re-open such approved parking place by the removal of the said notice.
10. This order may be cited as the Parking Places Order, 1963.
11. This order shall come into force on the twelfth day of August nineteen hundred and sixty three.

APPROVED PARKING PLACES

<u>No.</u>	<u>Situation</u>	<u>Approved Parking Places</u>
1.	Saint James Street	On the north side of the street between signs which are placed opposite the entrance to New Street and near east end of Saint Paul's.
2.	Hirzel Street Saint Peter Port	On the east side of the street between signs which are placed near the side entrance to Hirzel House and a point 130 feet northwards.
3.	Ann's Place Saint Peter Port	On the south side of the road between signs which are placed opposite O.G.H. Hotel and the Government Office.
4.	Saint Julian's Avenue Saint Peter Port	On the north west side of the road between signs which are placed at the top near the seventh tree and the entrance to the Canichers.
5 A.	Glatigny Esplanade Saint Peter Port	On the east side of the road between signs which are placed near the top of slipway opposite Royal Hotel and opposite Well Road.
5 B.		On the west side of the road between signs placed near the Royal Hotel and Channel Islands Hotel.
6.	Salerie Battery Saint Peter Port	On the Battery clear of footpath.
7.	Saint George's Esplanade Saint Peter Port	On the north side of the road between signs placed opposite Piette Road and opposite Bouillon Lane.
8.	White Rock Saint Peter Port	On the quay side between signs placed near the lamp post at Saint Julian's Weighbridge and near the London Berth.
9.	Victoria Pier Saint Peter Port	Round the edges of the Pier and down the centre of the Pier from east to west.
10.	South Esplanade and Albert Pier Saint Peter Port	1. Omnibus Park - east side of Plantation from Albert Statue to Slaughterhouse. 2. Car Park - Albert Pier and red light berths.
11.	Bonded Stores Saint Peter Port	On the west side of the road between signs placed opposite the west door of Town Church and near the bottom of Rectory House steps.
12.	Cornet Street Saint Peter Port	On the west side of the road between signs placed near the entrance to Mignot Plateau and opposite Coupée Lane.

13.	Fountain Street Saint Peter Port	On the north side of the street between signs placed at the west end of the Market and near the south entrance to Church Square.
14.	Market Street (over Bonded Stores) Saint Peter Port	On the east side of the road between signs placed near the top of Rectory House steps and opposite Market Hall.
15.	Market Square Saint Peter Port	South side
16.	Market Street Saint Peter Port	South side
17 A.	Clifton Saint Peter Port	On the west side of the road between signs placed opposite Le Platon and opposite Clifton steps.
17 B.		Between signs opposite Salvation Army Hall and opposite Berthelot Street.
18 A.	New Street Saint Peter Port	On the east side of the road between signs placed opposite the prison and near corner of Lefebvre Street.
18 B.		On the west side of the road between signs placed opposite Lefebvre Street and between houses numbered 15 and 17.
19.	Upland Road Saint Peter Port	On the east side of the road between signs placed near the pump and near the top of Rue des Frères.
20.	Monument Road Saint Peter Port	On the south side of the road alongside wall between signs placed near top and bottom of road.
21.	Arsenal Road Saint Peter Port	On the plantation side between signs placed near each end of the plantation and near the centre of plantation.
22.	Route Isabelle Saint Peter Port	On the south side of the road between signs placed near the Hermitage.
23.	Saint Stephen's Lane Saint Peter Port	On the west side of the lane between signs placed near the entrance to Saint Stephen's Church and near the bottom of lane.
24.	Couperderie Road Saint Peter Port	On the north side of the road alongside kerb. Between signs placed near the junction of Victoria Road and near the curve in wall.
25.	Victoria Terrace Saint Peter Port	Between signs placed opposite the steps leading to Valnord and ten yards from the corner of Valnord.
26.	Valnord Saint Peter Port	On the west side between signs placed near the bottom of Petite Fontaine Lane and near the curve in wall.

27.	Top of Hauteville Saint Peter Port	Between signs painted in road near the pillar box at triangle.
28.	South side of harbour Saint Sampson's	On the north side of the road between signs placed on the kerb opposite New Road and near the Harbour Master's Office.
29.	Bulwer Avenue (Richmond Corner end) Saint Sampson's	Between signs placed near the sea wall.
30.	Routes des Coutures Vale	On the east side of the road between signs on the kerb.
31.	Rue de la Villetole, Pleinmont, Torteval	Between signs placed near the bottom and near the top of road.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This order supersedes the Ordinances regulating parking places hitherto in force. It designates certain areas and parts of public highways as approved parking places and prescribes the conditions subject to which parking may take place therein. Apart from minor changes it consolidates the existing provisions.
