THE EXPORT OF TOMATOES (PACKING AND GRADING) ORDER, 1962.

The States Committee for Horticulture, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (3) of section two of the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1961, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. On and before the fourth day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-two, a person shall not deliver tomatoes to the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") for export otherwise than in containers designed to contain six pounds of tomatoes.
2. On and after the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-two, a person shall not deliver tomatoes to the Board for export otherwise than in containers designed to contain twelve pounds of tomatoes.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

Explanatory Note.

(This note is not part of the Order, but is  
intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order prescribes the sizes of the containers to be used for the delivery of tomatoes to the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board for export, as follows:-

Up to and including the 4th May, 1962 - six pound  
containers only.

As and from the 7th May, 1962 - twelve pound containers  
only.

NOTE. On the 5th May, 1962, only, to enable growers to clear their stocks of six pound containers, tomatoes will be accepted in either size of container.
