The Aliens (Landing and Embarkation) (Cards) Order, 1962.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section six of the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, I hereby order:-

1. The landing card which an alien of or over the age of sixteen years landing in the Bailiwick is obliged by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section six of the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, (hereinafter referred to as "the Aliens Law") to produce to an immigration officer if that officer so requires shall be white in colour and shall be in the form set out in the First Schedule to this order.

2. The embarkation card which an alien of or over the age of sixteen years embarking in the Bailiwick is obliged by paragraph (b) subsection (1) of section six of the Aliens Law to produce to an immigration officer if that officer so requires shall be yellow in colour and shall be in the form set out in the Second Schedule to this Order.

3. The landing and embarkation cards set out in the Schedules to this Order shall measure four inches in depth and six inches in width and shall be made of stout cardboard of a substance of not less than two hundred grammes per square metre and not more than two hundred and sixty grammes per square metre.

4. The Aliens (Landing and Embarkation) (Cards) Order, 1959, is hereby revoked.

5. This Order shall come into force on the second day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-two.
