IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1962

The Board of Administration in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, (a), as amended, is hereby further amended as follows -
 - (a) section 7A thereof is hereby deleted;
 - (b) in the Second Schedule thereto, the references to "live poultry, poultry carcasses other than carcasses which are fully cooked and eggs" are hereby deleted.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1962, and shall come into force on the 20th day of June, 1962.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is for information only and forms no part of the Order)

The effect of the above Order is that as from the 20th June, 1962, there will be no restrictions under the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, as amended, on the exportation of live poultry, poultry carcasses other than carcasses which are fully cooked and eggs to the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man. The exportation of live poultry, poultry carcasses other than carcasses which are fully cooked and eggs to the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is, however, the subject of restrictions imposed by the Poultry and Hatching Eggs (Importation and Exportation) Ordinance, 1962.
