THE ALIENS (REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA) DIRECTION, 1962

Made 24th July, 1962
Coming into Operation 25th July, 1962.

The States Board of Administration, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section twenty-two of the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, hereby gives the following Direction:-

1. An alien to whom this Direction applies shall, until the expiry of the month of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-two, be exempt from the provisions of sections thirteen to sixteen of the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, as amended by the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1962 (which sections provide for the registration of certain aliens).

2. This Direction applies to any person who was -

- (a) a citizen of the Republic of South Africa, or
- (b) a British protected person by virtue of his connection with the mandated territory of South West Africa,

immediately before thirty-first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-two (being the date on which under the South Africa Act, 1962, any person who immediately before that date was a British Subject by reason only of his citizenship of the Republic of South Africa ceased to be a British Subject).

3. This Direction may be cited as the Aliens (Republic of South Africa) Direction, 1962, and shall come into operation on the twenty-fifth day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-two.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Direction, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Under the South Africa Act, 1962, persons who were British Subjects by virtue only of their citizenship of the Republic of South Africa ceased to be British Subjects on 31st May, 1962, and on the same date persons who were British protected persons by virtue of their connection with South West Africa ceased to be British protected persons. Under this Direction, from the date of its coming into force until 31st December, 1962, persons who immediately before 31st May, 1962, were citizens of the Republic of South Africa or British protected persons by reason of their connection with South West Africa will be exempt from those provisions of the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, which relate to the registration of
