Regulations made by the States Board of Administration under Article 1 of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative aux Marchés Publics, aux Abattoirs et à la Vente de la Viande" of the twentieth day of April, nineteen hundred and eighteen, as amended by the Public Markets, Slaughterhouses and Sale of Meat (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962.

The Public Markets, Slaughterhouses and Sale of Meat Regulations approved by the Royal Court on the twenty-second day of November, nineteen hundred and nineteen, as amended, are hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:-

- (a) Regulation 7 thereof is hereby repealed and the following Regulations is hereby substituted therefor -

"7. Except with the written permission of the States Board of Administration, a person shall not sell or expose for sale in the Meat Market anything other than meat or meat products.";

- (b) in Regulation 15 thereof, the words "Nothing but fish, poultry, Guernsey grown fruit, Guernsey grown vegetables, Guernsey eggs and Guernsey butter may be sold or exposed for sale in the Fish Market" are hereby repealed;

- (c) immediately after Regulation 15 thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional Regulation 15A -

"15A. - Except with the written permission of the States Board of Administration, a person shall not sell or expose for sale in the Fish Market anything other than fish, poultry, Guernsey grown fruit, Guernsey grown vegetables, Guernsey eggs and Guernsey butter."
