THE TOMATO MARKETING (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1960.

The States Committee for Horticulture, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2A) of section two of the Tomato Marketing (Guernsey) Law, 1952, as amended, hereby order:-

1. For the purposes of section two of the Tomato Marketing (Guernsey) Law, 1952, as amended, tomatoes shall be graded as follows:-
 - (a) Select Sunrise;
 - (b) Select Star;
 - (c) Select Diamond;
 - (d) Select Circle;
 - (e) Triangle;
 - (f) Square;
 - (g) Smalls;

in the manner provided for those grades respectively in subsection (2) of section four of the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1953, as amended.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd January, 1961

Explanatory Note.

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order prescribes the grades of tomatoes for the purpose of assessing the amount attributable to each producer in respect of his tomatoes exported by the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board, on a particular day or during a particular period.
