

THE TOMATO MARKETING (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1961.

The States Committee for Horticulture, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2A) of section two of the Tomato Marketing (Guernsey) Law, 1952, as amended, hereby order:-

1. (1) For the purposes of section two of the Tomato Marketing (Guernsey) Law, 1952, as amended, tomatoes shall be graded -
 - (a) in the case of tomatoes packed in a container which is marked with the words "OUTDOOR GROWN", as OUTDOOR GROWN TOMATOES; and
 - (b) in any other case, as INDOOR GROWN TOMATOES.
- (2) For the purposes of the said section two, tomatoes in each of the aforesaid grades shall be further graded as follows:-
 - (a) Pink;
 - (b) Pink and White;
 - (c) Pink and White Cross;
 - (d) White;
 - (e) Blue;
 - (f) Domestic;
 - (g) Smalls;

in the manner provided for those grades respectively in subsection (2) of section four of the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1961.

2. The Tomato Marketing (Guernsey) Order, 1960, is hereby repealed.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th March, 1961.

Explanatory Note.

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order prescribes the grades of tomatoes for the purpose of assessing the amount attributable to each producer in respect of his tomatoes exported by the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board, on a particular day or during a particular period. Under the Order, separate amounts are attributable in respect of outdoor grown tomatoes.
