THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (CONTROL OF EXPORT AND DELIVERY
FOR EXPORT) (No. 7) REGULATIONS, 1961

Made 28th March, 1961.
Coming into operation 1st April, 1961.

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section three of the Export of Produce (Control of Export and Delivery for Export) Ordinance, 1956, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. On the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, tomatoes shall not be delivered to the Harbour of Saint Peter Port for export as Fast Train Traffic later than 7.00 a.m.
2. The Export of Produce (Control of Export and Delivery for Export) (No. 6) Regulations 1961, are hereby repealed.
3. These Regulations shall come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-one.
