The Import Duties (European Free Trade Association)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1961

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by section two of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Guernsey) Order, 1960 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) paragraph (a) of section two thereof is hereby repealed and the following paragraph substituted therefor -

"(a) in the case of goods of any description specified in the Second Schedule to this Order, no import duty shall be charged;"

(b) in paragraph (b) of section two thereof the words "one-fifth" are hereby deleted and the words "three-tenths" are hereby substituted therefor;

(c) in the Second Schedule thereto the headings "Particular Convention Rates of Duty" and "Convention rate" and the figure and symbol "5%" are hereby deleted.

2. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1961, and this Order and the principal Order may be cited together as the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Guernsey) Orders, 1960 and 1961.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-one.
