THE POTATOES IMPORTATION (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1961

The States Committee for Horticulture, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section six of the Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinance, 1951, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The Potatoes Importation Order, 1958 (a) is hereby repealed.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st December, 1961.

Explanatory Note.

(This note is not part of the Order,
but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of this Order is to prohibit the landing or transshipment in this Island of potatoes from any country in the Continent of Europe unless they are shipped directly from and have previously been landed in the United Kingdom, the Republic of Ireland, the Isle of Man or one of the other Channel Islands.
