THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (OTHER THAN TOMATOES) ORDER, 1961.

The States Committee for Horticulture, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2) of section four of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. Immediately after section three of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) Order, 1956(a), as amended (b), there shall be inserted the following additional section, numbered "3A":-  

"3A. Where a container containing produce is to be exported to a consignee in Borough Market, Covent Garden Market or Spitalfields Market, the imprint on the container or on the label attached thereto, in pursuance of subsection (1) of section four of the principal Ordinance, shall, in addition to the requirements set out in the last preceding section, include, on the right hand side thereof, in bold figures of not less than one and one-half inches in height, such number as may be prescribed from time to time by the Committee as respects such consignee."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of February, 1962.

Explanatory Note.

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order provides that in the case of produce to be exported to consignees in Borough Market, Covent Garden Market and Spitalfields Market, the imprint on the container or on the label attached thereto, shall include in bold figures of not less than 1½ inches in height, such number as may be prescribed from time to time by the Committee as respects such consignee.
