

THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (CONTROL OF EXPORT AND DELIVERY
FOR EXPORT) (No. 12) REGULATIONS, 1960.

Made 23rd April, 1960.
Coming into operation 25th April, 1960.

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section three of the Export of Produce (Control of Export and Delivery for Export) Ordinance, 1956, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. For the purposes of these Regulations, the expression "produce" means produce, other than tomatoes.
2. On and after the date of the coming into force of these Regulations, produce shall not be delivered for export as East Train traffic to the Harbour of Saint Peter Port on any day in any week other than on any of the days set out in the left-hand column of the Schedule to these Regulations and shall not be delivered for export on any of those days to the said Harbour later than the times set out in the right-hand column of the said Schedule respectively.
3. The Export of Produce (Control of Export and Delivery for Export) (No. 10) Regulations, 1960, are hereby repealed.
4. These Regulations shall come into force on the twenty-fifth day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty.
