The Import Duties (European Free Trade Association)  
(Guernsey) Order, 1960

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by section two of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. This Order applies to goods grown, produced or manufactured in, and consigned to the Bailiwick from a place in, the Convention area, other than goods of any description specified in the First Schedule to this Order which do not fall within the Second Schedule thereto.
2. Where goods to which this Order applies are imported into the Bailiwick and (apart from this Order) import duty would be charged on that importation under the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 34) Order, 1959 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") then -
  - (a) in the case of goods of any description specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order -
    - (i) if a rate of duty is shown in relation to the goods in the second column of the said Second Schedule, the amount of duty chargeable as aforesaid shall be determined as if the said rate were substituted for the relevant rate shown in the second column of the Second Schedule to the principal Order,
    - (ii) if no rate of duty is shown in relation to the goods in the second column of the Second Schedule to this Order, no import duty shall be charged;
  - (b) in the case of goods of any description not so specified, the amount of duty chargeable as aforesaid shall be determined as if the relevant rate shown in the second column of the Second Schedule to the principal Order were less by one-fifth.
3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Guernsey) Order, 1960.
  - (2) References in the Schedules to this Order to Chapters, headings or sub-headings are references to Chapters, headings or sub-headings of the first column of the Second Schedule to the principal Order.
  - (3) For the purposes of this Order, the expression "the Convention area" has the meaning assigned to it by the European Free Trade Association (Guernsey) Law, 1960.

- (4) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
- (5) This Order shall come into operation on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Goods to which this Order does not apply

Description of goods

- Goods of any heading of Chapter 1 or 2.
- Goods of any heading of Chapter 3 except fillets of fish, chilled or frozen, falling within heading 03.01 and except peeled prawns, chilled or frozen, falling within heading 03.03, other than Dublin Bay prawns.
- Goods of any heading of Chapter 4.
- Goods of heading 05.04.
- Goods of heading 05.15 except blood powder, blood plasma, and salted fish roes.
- Goods of any heading of Chapter 6, 7 or 8.
- Goods of any heading of Chapter 9 except 09.03.
- Goods of any heading of Chapter 10 or 11.
- Goods of any heading of Chapter 12 other than 12.07; the following goods of heading 12.07; that is to say, basil, borage, mint (excluding dried peppermint and pennyroyal), rosemary and sage.
- Pectin (of heading 13.03).
- Goods of heading 15.01, 15.02, 15.03, 15.06 or 15.07.
- Goods of heading 15.12 except fats and oils wholly obtained from fish or marine mammals.
- Goods of heading 15.13.
- Goods of heading 16.01, 16.02 or 16.03.
- Goods of any heading of Chapter 17 other than 17.04; the following goods of heading 17.04; that is to say, fondant, pastes, creams and similar intermediate products, in bulk, containing 80 per cent or more by weight of added sweetening matter.
- Goods of heading 18.01 or 18.02.
- Goods of heading 19.02, 19.03 or 19.04.
- Goods of heading 19.07 except ships' biscuits, crumbs and rusks.
- Goods of heading 19.08 except biscuits, wafers, rusks, cakes without covering or filling, and pastry of the kind known as Danish pastry.
- Goods of any heading of Chapter 20 except the following goods of heading 20.02, that is to say, tomato pulp or paste, in airtight containers, wholly of tomato and water apart from salt or any other preserving, seasoning or flavouring ingredients, the dry weight of the tomato in any container being not less than 25 per cent of the weight of the contents.
- Pressed yeast (of heading 21.06).

- The following goods of heading 21.07, that is to say -
- (a) ice cream (containing fat) but not including ice cream powder;
  - (b) mixtures of water and emulsifying agents with fat or oil (not including synthetic cream);
  - (c) coffee pastes (mixtures of ground, roasted coffee with vegetable fats, with or without other ingredients);
  - (d) sweetfat (mixtures of edible fats and sugar);
  - (e) ravioli, macaroni, spaghetti and the like, cooked (other than rice and other whole cereal grains), whether or not stuffed with other substances or admixed with tomato sauce.

Goods of heading 22.04, 22.05, 22.06, 22.07 or 22.10.

Goods of heading 23.02, 23.03 or 23.04.

Goods of heading 23.06 except seaweed meal.

Goods of heading 23.07 except fish solubles.

Goods of heading 24.01.

Goods of heading 35.01 except casein glues.
