THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (CONTROL OF EXPORT AND DELIVERY FOR EXPORT) (NO. 16) REGULATIONS, 1960

Made .. .. . 12th July, 1960.  
 Coming into operation .. .. . 18th July, 1960.

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section three of the Export of Produce (Control of Export and Delivery for Export) Ordinance, 1956, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. On and after the eighteenth day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty, tomatoes shall not be delivered to the Harbour of Saint Peter Port for export by cargo boat on any day in any week other than on any of the days set out in the left-hand column of the Schedule to these Regulations and shall not be delivered for export otherwise than by the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board on any of those days to the said Harbour later than the times set out in the right-hand column of the said Schedule respectively.
2. The Export of Produce (Control of Export and Delivery for Export) (No. 15) Regulations, 1960, are hereby repealed.
3. These Regulations shall come into force on the eighteenth day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty.
