

**The Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified
Copies of Documents) Regulations, 2012**

THE TREASURY AND RESOURCES DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Registration fees for documents

1. In section 1 of the Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified Copies of Documents) Ordinance, 1960^b ("the 1960 Ordinance") -

- (a) in paragraph (a) for "£50" substitute "£55",
- (b) in paragraphs (b) and (c) for "£4.00" substitute "£4.50".

Fees for certified copies of documents

2. In section 2 of the 1960 Ordinance -
 - (a) in paragraph (a) for "£2.50" substitute "£3.00"^c,
 - (b) in paragraph (b) for "£4.50" substitute "£5.00"^c.

Fees for uncertified copies of registered documents

3. In section 2A of the 1960 Ordinance: -
 - (a) in paragraphs (a) and (b)(ii) for "£1.25" substitute "£1.50"^c,
 - (b) in paragraph (b)(i) for "£3.50" substitute "£4.00"^c.

Fees in respect of documents creating charge on land

4. In paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 2B of the 1960 Ordinance for "£35" substitute "£40".

Repeal

5. The Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified Copies of Documents) Regulations, 2010^d are repealed.

Citation

6. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified Copies of Documents) Regulations, 2012.


