THE SWINE FEVER ORDINANCES, 1955 TO 1959

THE SWINE FEVER (INFECTED AREA)(REVOCATION) No. 2 ORDER, 1959

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of section
twenty-one of the Swine Fever Ordinance, 1955, ^{as amended} the

Board of Administration hereby orders:-

1. The Swine Fever (Infected Area)(No. 3) Order, 1959 dated the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred and fi ty-nine, is hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the eighteenth day of May, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport)

The effect of this Order is that as from 18th May, 1959, the area within one half mile of the piggery and farm buildings at Les Vauxbelets is no longer an Infected Area for the purposes of the Swine Fever Ordinances 1955 and 1959, and the export of swine from Guernsey, Herm and Jethou is no longer prohibited.
