THE SWINE FEVER (INFECTED AREA) (No. 4) ORDER, 1959

The States Board of Administration, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section twenty-one of the Swine Fever Ordinance, 1955, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The following areas are hereby declared to be Infected Areas:-
 - (a) an area enclosed by the circumference of a circle the centre of which is the piggery behind the Camp du Roi Printing Works, Camp du Roi, situate in the parish of the Vale and the radius of which is one half of one mile;
 - (b) an area enclosed by the circumference of a circle the centre of which is the piggery at the back of Maple Lodge farm-house, Anneville, situate in the parish of the Vale and the radius of which is one half of one mile;
 - (c) an area enclosed by the circumference of a circle the centre of which is the piggery at the back of the house known as Les Pieces, Forest Road, situate in the parish of the Forest and the radius of which is one half of one mile.
2. The export of any swine from any of the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou is hereby prohibited.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 23rd day of May, 1959.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of this Order is to prohibit the movement of any swine and any carcases of swine out of or into an area within one half mile of the piggeries behind the Camp du Roi Printing Works; Maple Lodge farm-house; and Les Pieces, Forest Road, and to prohibit the export of any swine and any carcases of swine from Guernsey, Herm and Jethou. This Order also brings into operation restrictions on the movement and slaughter of swine in the infected area and the requirement that in certain circumstances the death of swine shall be reported to the States Veterinary Officer.
