THE SWINE FEVER ORDINANCES, 1955 AND 1959

THE SWINE FEVER (INFECTED AREA) (REVOCATION) No. 3 ORDER, 1959.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of section twenty-one of the Swine Fever Ordinance, 1955, as amended, the Board of Administration hereby orders:-

1. The Swine Fever (Infected Area) (No. 4) Order, 1959, dated the twenty-third day of May, 1959, is hereby revoked.
2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport)

The effect of this Order is that as from 27th May, 1959, the areas within one half mile of the piggeries behind the Camp du Roi Printing Works; Maple Lodge farm-house; and Les Pièces, Forest Road, are no longer Infected Areas for the purposes of the Swine Fever Ordinances 1955 and 1959, and the export of swine and any carcasses of swine from Guernsey, Herm and Jethou is no longer prohibited. The effect of this Order is also to remove the restrictions on the movement and slaughter of swine in the hitherto Infected Areas and to dispense with the requirement that in certain circumstances the death of swine shall be reported to the States Veterinary Officer.
