The Import Duties (Dailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 36) Order, 1959

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Import Duties (Dailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1953, hereby orders:-

1. In the Second Schedule to the Import Duties (Dailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 34) Order, 1959, there shall be made in the headings specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order the amendments set out in the second column of that Schedule.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Dailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 36) Order, 1959.  
(2) This Order shall come into operation in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney on the first day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, and in the Island of Sark so soon thereafter as the provisions of the Import Duties (Dailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1953, with reference to the putting into operation therein of this Order shall have been complied with.
