THE IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL)(GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL)(NO. 2)(GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1959.

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control)(Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1955, (a), as amended, is hereby further amended as follows -

- (a) immediately after section 7A thereof, there is hereby inserted the following additional section numbered "7B"-

"7B. For the purposes of the First Schedule to this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them -

"animal" means any horse, mare, gelding, pony, foal, colt, filly, stallion, ass, donkey, mule, bull, cow, bullock, heifer, calf, steer, ox, sheep, ewe, wether, ram, lamb, pig, boar, hog, sow, goat and kid;

"poultry" means domestic fowl, turkeys, geese, ducks, and guinea-fowl";

- (b) in the First Schedule thereto there is hereby inserted, immediately before the reference to "Caravans", the following additional reference -

"Animal and poultry excrement".

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control)(No. 2) (Guernsey) Order, 1959, and shall come into force on the eleventh day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of the above Order is to prohibit, with effect from the eleventh day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, the importation of animal and poultry excrement from the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man, Jersey and the other Islands of this Bailiwick otherwise than under the authority of a licence granted by the Board of Administration.
