THE SWINE FEVER ORDINANCES, 1955 TO 1959

*Revocation Order*

THE SWINE FEVER (INFECTED AREA) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1959

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of section twenty-one of the Swine Fever Ordinances, 1955 and 1959, the Board of Administration hereby orders:-

1. The Swine Fever (Infected Area) (No. 2) Order, 1959 dated the twenty-fourth day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, is hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the eleventh day of February, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport)

The effect of this Order is that as from the 11th February, 1959, the Island of Guernsey is no longer an Infected Area for the purposes of the Swine Fever Ordinances, 1955 and 1959, and the export of swine from that Island and the Islands of Herm and Jethou is no longer prohibited.
