THE HAY, STRAW AND LITTER (IMPORTATION) (No. 2) ORDER, 1959

The States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by sections four and five of the Importation of Hay, Straw and Litter Ordinance, 1950, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The reference to the countries specified in the Schedule to this Order are hereby deleted from the Schedule to the Hay, Straw and Litter (Importation) Order, 1950 (a).
2. The importation into Guernsey of hay, straw or litter from the Island of Jersey is hereby prohibited unless -
 - (a) the hay, straw or litter was grown in the said Island of Jersey and each consignment thereof is accompanied by a certificate signed by a responsible official of the States Committee of Agriculture of that Island certifying that there has not been an outbreak of foot and mouth disease on the premises where the said consignment or any part thereof was grown or stored during the twelve months preceding such importation; or
 - (b) the hay, straw or litter was grown in the United Kingdom or in Norway and each consignment thereof is accompanied by -
 - (i) a declaration from the consignor in the Island of Jersey stating that the hay, straw or litter comprising the consignment was imported directly into the Island of Jersey from the United Kingdom or Norway, as the case may be;
 - (ii) a certificate signed by a responsible official of the States Committee of Agriculture of that Island certifying that the hay, straw or litter comprising the consignment was, when imported into the Island of Jersey, accompanied by such declarations and certificates required to accompany consignments of hay, straw or litter imported into the Island of Jersey from the United Kingdom or Norway, as the case may be, under the provisions of any enactment for the time being in force in the said Island of Jersey; and
 - (iii) a certificate signed by a responsible official of the States Committee of Agriculture of that Island certifying that there has not been an outbreak of foot and mouth disease on the premises where the said consignment or any part thereof was stored during the twelve months preceding such importation.

3. The Hay, Straw and Litter (Importation) (No. 2) Order, 1958 (b), is hereby repealed.
4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd day of March, 1959.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but
is intended to indicate its general purport)

This Order removes Estonia, Poland and Lithuania from the list of countries from which the importation into Guernsey, Herm and Jethou of hay, straw and litter is permitted subject to certain conditions. The Order also permits the importation into Guernsey, Herm and Jethou of hay, straw and litter which has first been imported into Jersey from the United Kingdom or Norway, subject to certain conditions.
