The Safety of Employees (Growing Properties)
(Poisonous Substances and Regulated Operations) Order, 1958
(Revocation) Order, 1959

THE STATES LABOUR AND WELFARE COMMITTEE, as the Administering Authority constituted by the States under the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950, and in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section fifteen and section eighteen of the Safety of Employees (Growing Properties) Ordinance, 1954, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Safety of Employees (Growing Properties) (Poisonous Substances and Regulated Operations) Order, 1958, is hereby revoked.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the Tenth day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.

This Order removes from control under the Safety of Employees (Growing Properties) Ordinance, 1954, sodium methyldithiocarbamate, the common name of which is vapam or sistan, and operations involving the use of that substance.
