SPENT

The Aliens (Places of Detention) Order, 1959

In pursuance of the power conferred upon me by subsection (2) of section twenty-eight of the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, I hereby order:-

1. The places in which aliens shall be detained under the provisions hereinafter mentioned of the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, shall be -

- (a) in the case of an alien detained under subsection (3) of section six of the said Law (which provides for the examination of aliens seeking to land in the Bailiwick), any place in which examinations under that section are conducted at the port at which the alien has landed;
- (b) in the case of an alien detained under subsection (4) of section seven of the said Law (which relates to aliens to whom leave to land has been refused), any place used by an immigration officer for the purposes of his functions at the port at which the alien has been refused leave to land or any place specially provided for the purpose of detention at that port or the police station or the States Prison;
- (c) in the case of an alien detained under the said subsection (4) of section seven of the said Law as applied by section eight thereof (which section, as so applied, relates to aliens who have landed unlawfully in the Bailiwick and to certain alien seamen), the police station or the States Prison;
- (d) in the case of an alien detained under subsection (4) of section twenty of the said Law by reason of the making of a deportation order or the giving of a certificate by a court recommending the making of a deportation order, the police station or the States Prison.

2. An alien shall not be detained under the provisions
aforesaid for more than five days elsewhere than in the States Prison.

3. This Order shall come into force on the nineteenth day
of March, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.
