THE IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1959.

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955^(a), as amended, is hereby further amended as follows -

(a) immediately after section seven thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional section numbered "7A" -

"7A. For the purposes of the Second Schedule to this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them -

"poultry" means domestic fowl, turkeys, geese, ducks and guinea-fowl;

"carcase" means the carcase of poultry and includes any part of any carcase;

"fully cooked" when used in connection with a carcase means cooked throughout the whole of its substance so as to render it unnecessary for it to be further cooked before being used for human consumption;

"eggs" means the eggs of poultry."

(b) in the Second Schedule thereto there are hereby inserted, immediately after the reference to "Flower bulbs", the following additional references -

"Live poultry.

Poultry carcases other than carcases which are fully cooked.
Eggs."

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1959, and shall come into force on the fifteenth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is for information only and forms no part of the Order.)

The effect of the above Order is to prohibit, with effect from the fifteenth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, the exportation of live poultry, poultry carcases and poultry eggs to the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man, Jersey and the other Islands of this Bailiwick otherwise than under the authority of a licence granted by the Board of Administration.
