The Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946

The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1958

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of Article I of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders:-

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article four of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, as amended, the importation of milk and milk products consigned from the Island of Alderney is hereby prohibited.

2. For the purposes of this Order, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them -

"milk" means liquid cow's milk whether whole, separated or skimmed and includes any liquid consisting wholly or mainly of liquid cow's milk as aforesaid but does not include any liquid cow's milk as aforesaid or any liquid as aforesaid contained in any hermetically sealed tin;

"milk product" means any product manufactured in the Island of Alderney wholly or mainly from milk.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1958, and shall come into force on the eleventh day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
