

## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1958 No. 8

THE ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS (IMPORTATION)(NO. 2) ORDER, 1958

The States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section eleven of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The importation into the Island from the Island of Jersey of sheep, goats and all other ruminating animals and carcasses, is hereby prohibited.
2. The importation into the Island from the Island of Jersey of swine is hereby prohibited unless, in respect of each consignment thereof, the following conditions are complied with:-
  - (a) there shall have been issued by the Committee a licence in that behalf;
  - (b) the swine shall be accompanied by -
    - (i) a certificate from a Veterinary Surgeon certifying that the swine and the farm from which they come have been examined by him and are free from all infectious diseases of swine, such examination having been made and such certificate having been issued not more than forty-eight hours before the swine were despatched;
    - (ii) a certificate from a Veterinary Surgeon certifying that the swine have been submitted to the Single Intradermal Tuberculin Test using both avian and mammalian tuberculin and that the swine have not reacted to either test, such test having been carried out not more than 14 days before the swine were despatched;
    - (iii) ~~a certificate from a Veterinary Surgeon certifying that the swine were vaccinated with crystal violet vaccine not more than six months, but not less than fourteen days, before the swine were despatched;~~
    - (iv) a certificate from an official authorised in that behalf by the States of Jersey Committee of Agriculture certifying that the existence of atrophic rhinitis has not been suspected or confirmed on the premises from which the swine come or on any other premises on which they have been during the three months immediately preceding the date of despatch of the swine;
    - (v) a certificate from an official authorised in that behalf by the States of Jersey Committee of Agriculture certifying that the Island of Jersey is free, and has been free during the period of three months immediately preceding the date of despatch of the swine, from foot and mouth disease and swine fever, such certificate having been issued not more than forty-eight hours before the swine were despatched;

(c) the swine shall, on landing in the Island, be placed in quarantine for a period of not less than fourteen days in such place and under such conditions as shall be specified by the States Supervisor.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of this Order carcasses of swine may be imported into the Island from the Island of Jersey, provided they are accompanied by a certificate issued by the States Veterinary Officer certifying that the carcasses were not imported into the Island of Jersey.
4. The Animals and Animal Products Importation Order, 1957 (a), is hereby repealed.
5. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
6. This Order shall come into operation on the 27th January, 1958.
