THE POTATOES IMPORTATION ORDER, 1958

The States Committee for Horticulture, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section six of the Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinance, 1951, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. A person may land or tranship in this Island potatoes from any country in the Continent of Europe, other than France, provided that each consignment thereof is accompanied by a certificate in the form set out in the First Schedule to this Order and by a certificate in the form set out in the Second Schedule to this Order.
2. The certificates provided for by section one of this Order to accompany each consignment shall be signed by a duly authorised official of the Phytopathological Service of the country in which the potatoes included in the consignment were grown.
3. The Potatoes Importation Order 1955 (a), is hereby repealed.
4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 27th day of March, 1958.
