THE ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS (IMPORTATION) (No. 3) ORDER, 1958

The States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section eleven of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The importation into the Island from the Island of Alderney of swine is hereby prohibited unless, in respect of each consignment thereof, the following conditions are complied with:-

- (a) there shall have been issued by the Committee a licence in that behalf;

- (b) the swine shall, on landing in the Island, be placed in quarantine for a period of not less than fourteen days in such place and under such conditions as shall be specified by the States Supervisor;

- ~~(c) the swine whilst in quarantine may be vaccinated with crystal violet vaccine by the States Veterinary Officer.~~

2. The Animals and Animal Products Importation Order, 1958 (a), is hereby repealed.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 10th April, 1958.
