The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Revocation) (Guernsey)
Order, 1958.

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of Article I of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1958, is hereby revoked.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Revocation) (Guernsey) Order, 1958" and shall come into force on the ninth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
