THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL)(GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1955.

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1955, dated the 14th June, 1955, (a) the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

Now, therefore, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. In the reference to "Fats, greases and oils, animal (excluding marine animal)" in Group 1 of Schedule III to the Open General Import Licence dated the twenty-third day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, immediately after the word "Butter" there are hereby inserted the words "other than Butter consigned from and originating in Belgium".
2. This amendment shall take effect on the 28th day of May, 1958, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the Board of Administration.
