THE IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Revocation) (No.2) (Guernsey)
Order, 1958

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders:-

1. In the Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, as amended, (a), the following words are hereby deleted -

"Fish, canned, of the following varieties:-

Salmon (including salmon trout), other than smoked salmon."

2. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, Amendment Order, 1955 (b), is hereby revoked.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Revocation) (No.2) (Guernsey) Order, 1958, and shall come into force on the eighth day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is for information only and forms no part of the Order).

The effect of the above Order is to permit as from the 8th October, 1958, the exportation of canned salmon (including salmon trout) to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey, or the Isle of Man, without the necessity to obtain an export licence.
