THE HAY, STRAW AND LITTER (IMPORTATION) (NO. 2) ORDER, 1958

The States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section four of the Importation of Hay, Straw and Litter Ordinance, 1950, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The importation into Guernsey of hay, straw and litter from the Island of Jersey is hereby prohibited unless each consignment thereof is accompanied by a certificate signed by a responsible official of the States Committee for Agriculture of that Island certifying that there has been no outbreak of Foot and Mouth Disease during the twelve months preceding such importation on the premises where the said consignment was grown.
2. The Hay, Straw and Litter Importation Order, 1957 (a), is hereby repealed.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 11th October, 1958.
