THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (OTHER THAN TOMATOES) (NO. 2) ORDER, 1958

The States Committee for Horticulture, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2) of section four of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. Subsection (2) of section three of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) Order, 1956 (a), is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (i) in paragraph (d) thereof the full-stop is hereby deleted and a semi-colon is hereby substituted therefor;
 - (ii) immediately after paragraph (d) there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph -

"(e) Brentford Market, be black."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1959.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

This Order adds Brentford Market to the London markets specified in the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) Order, 1956, which require special destination labels. The labels for produce sent to Brentford Market must be buff and marked with black lines forming a diagonal cross.
