THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES) (REVOCATION) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1958

Made ... .. 5th August, 1958  
Coming into operation ... .. 6th August, 1958

As Competent Authority as respects the Bailiwick of Guernsey, excluding the Island of Alderney, in relation to Regulation fifty-five of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Orders set out in the Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Revocation) (Guernsey) Order, 1958, and shall come into operation on the sixth day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
