THE MOTOR FUEL (BAILIWICK OF GUERNSEY)(No. 2) ORDER, 1956
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1957

As Competent Authorities as respects the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney, and as respects the Island of Alderney respectively, in relation to Regulation fifty-five of the Defence (General)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Motor Fuel (Bailiwick of Guernsey)(No. 2) Order, 1956, is hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and may be cited as the Motor Fuel (Bailiwick of Guernsey)(No. 2) Order, 1956 (Revocation) Order, 1957.
