THE ANIMAL PRODUCTS IMPORTATION ORDER, 1957

The States' Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section ten of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The importation of meat, including edible offal, into the Island from the Argentine, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Denmark, Netherlands, Switzerland or Uruguay shall be permitted provided that:-
 - (a) such meat shall have first been landed in Great Britain;
 - (b) in respect of each consignment of such meat there shall have been issued by the States' Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") a licence in that behalf; and
 - (c) any cloth, wrapping, sacking or other material which has been used for or in connection with the wrapping of such meat, including edible offal, shall, on arrival in the Island, be destroyed at the importer's expense in such manner as may be prescribed by the Committee.
2. The Animal Products Importation Order, 1954 (a), shall be repealed.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th May, 1957.
