1957 No 21.THE ANIMALS (EXTENSION OF DEFINITION) ORDER, 1957

The States' Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2) of section eleven of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. During the continuance in force of this Order, the definition of "animals" in section fifteen of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, shall be read and have effect as if the words "cats and dogs" were included therein for the purposes of subsection (1) of section eleven and of section fourteen of that Ordinance.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it shall apply to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation the 25th May, 1957.
