THE EXPORT OF BULBS ORDER, 1957

The States' Committee for Horticulture, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by the Export of Bulbs Ordinance, 1953, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The minimum period of notice to be given to an Inspector by a person desiring to export a consignment of bulbs shall be at least seventy-two hours.
2. The scale of charges in respect of the examination of bulbs made by an Inspector shall be:-
 - (a) 10s. Od. for each examination; and
 - (b) in respect of each consignment weighing one ton or more an additional 10s. Od. for each ton or part of a ton.
3. The certificate required to accompany each consignment of bulbs exported from the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou shall be in the form set out in the Schedule to this Order.
4. The Export of Bulbs Order, 1954 (a), and the Export of Bulbs Order, 1956 (b), shall be repealed.
5. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
6. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th June, 1957.
