THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES)(GUERNSEY)(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1957

Made 30th August, 1957.
Coming into operation 30th August, 1957.

As Competent Authority as respects the Bailiwick of Guernsey, excluding the Island of Alderney, in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. (1) The Schedule to the Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1956, as amended, is hereby revoked, and the Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor.
- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
2. The Fuel (Maximum Prices)(Guernsey)(Amendment)(No. 2) Order, 1956, is hereby revoked.
3. This Order may be cited as the Fuel (Maximum Prices)(Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1957, and shall come into operation on the thirtieth day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
