STATES OF GUERNSEYIMPORT DUTIES

The Import Duties (No.33) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1957, dated the 17th day of October, 1957, made by the States Board of Administration under and by virtue of the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1953.

WHEREAS the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1953, provide that (subject to the limitations therein provided) the States Board of Administration may, by Order, direct that there shall be chargeable on goods imported into the Bailiwick such duties as may be specified in the Order:

AND WHEREAS the said Laws empower the said Board, by a subsequent Order made in the like manner and subject to the like provisions, to vary or revoke any previous Order made under the provisions of the said Laws:

NOW THEREFORE, the States Board of Administration under and by virtue of the provisions of the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1953, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. Article two of the Import Duties (No.31) Order (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1956, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") shall have effect subject to -

- (a) the deletion of the full stop at the end of the Proviso thereto and the substitution therefor of a colon; and
- (b) the addition immediately after the said Proviso of the following additional Proviso:-

"Provided further that no charge to duty shall be made in respect of openwork wooden containers, whether unassembled, partly assembled or assembled, consisting wholly or mainly of veneer strips fastened together and known as broccoli crates or lettuce crates".

2. (1) This Order and the principal Order shall be construed as one.
- (2) Section two of Article two of the Import Duties (No.32) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1957, is hereby repealed.
- (3) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (No.33) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1957, and this Order, the Import Duties (No.32) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1957, and the principal Order may be cited together as the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Orders, 1956 and 1957.
- (4) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

3. This Order shall come into operation in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney on the twenty first day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and in the Island of Sark so soon thereafter as the provisions of the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1953, with reference to the putting into operation therein of this Order have been complied with.
