THE ANIMAL PRODUCTS IMPORTATION (NO. 4) ORDER, 1957

The States' Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section ten of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The importation into the Island of meat from Iceland which has first been landed in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland is hereby permitted.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th October, 1957.
