The Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1957

THE STATES DAIRY COMMITTEE, as Competent Authority in relation to Regulation fifty-five of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, as respects the Island of Guernsey, hereby makes the following order:-

1. A person licensed by the States Dairy Committee under the provisions of the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") to sell milk by retail shall not after the coming into force of this Order sell by retail any milk otherwise than milk packaged under the "Tetra Pak" method as so packed by the States Dairy Committee;

PROVIDED that a person licensed as aforesaid may sell loose milk by retail to a consumer if either -

- (a) that consumer purchases not less than six pots of milk on the day of such sale; or
- (b) that consumer has a medical certificate to the effect that it is desirable that he should have unpasteurised milk and if that consumer provides a suitable receptacle for the delivery of the milk to him by the retailer.

2. This Order and the principal Order shall be construed as one and may be cited together as the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Orders, 1954 and 1957.

3. This Order shall come into force on the sixth day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
