The Milk Prices (Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1957

THE STATES DAIRY COMMITTEE, in pursuance of a Resolution of the States of the twenty-fourth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by Regulation fifty-five of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. Paragraphs four and five of the Milk Prices (Guernsey) (No. 1) Order, 1957 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") are hereby repealed and the following paragraphs substituted therefor:-

"4. The price to be paid by individual milk retailers to the Committee as regards milk, whether produced locally or imported, shall be at the rate of two shillings, seven pence and one halfpenny per pot, subject to:-

- (a) a rebate of one halfpenny per pot on milk purchased up to and including the first thousand pots per week;
- (b) a rebate of one farthing per pot on purchases of milk from one thousand and one pots per week up to and including two thousand pots per week, with no rebate thereafter;

during the period commencing on the sixth day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and ending on the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.

5. The price to be paid by consumers to retailers as regards milk, whether produced locally or imported and whether delivered at the residence of the consumer or otherwise, shall be at the rate of nine pence per pint during the period commencing on the sixth day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and ending on the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight."

2. This Order may be cited as the Milk Prices (Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1957, and shall come into force on the sixth day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
