The Motor Fuel (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.3) Order, 1956

THE STATES OF GUERNSEY BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of Articles fourteen and fifteen of the Motor Fuel (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.2) Order, 1956, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. In this Order the expression "the principal Order" means the Motor Fuel (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.2) Order, 1956.
2. Pursuant to Article fourteen of the principal Order the quantities of motor fuel equivalent to one unit and half a unit with respect to any coupon shall be one gallon and half a gallon respectively.
3. Pursuant to Article fifteen of the principal Order, the period during which coupons shall be the authority for the supply of motor fuel against the surrender thereof shall be from the commencement of this Order until the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and may be cited as the Motor Fuel (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.3) Order, 1956.
