No 17IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1955,
AMENDMENT ORDER, 1956

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, (a), shall be amended by the addition thereto of the item -
"Poultry, dead or alive".
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 12th day of May, 1956, and may be cited as "The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, Amendment Order, 1956".

Explanatory Note

The effect of the above Order is that, as from the 12th May, 1956, the exportation of poultry, dead or alive, is prohibited, except under licence issued by the Board of Administration.
